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

OFFICIAL CONVENTION CALL

All endorsements for County Officers for Legion Year 2025-2026 will be taken up at the Nassau County 106th Convention to be held on June 14, 2025 at 9:00 AM, at Massapequa Post 1066, 66 Veterans Boulevard, Massapequa, New York 11758.

All Legionnaires who would like to run for a position on the Nassau County Staff for Legion Year 2025-2026 will get their endorsement from their respective Post, and under the signature of their Post Commander send a letter of endorsement to all Nassau County Posts, Past County Commanders, and the Nassau County Adjutant. All endorsements will be taken up at the Annual Nassau Convention.

The Convention is for the express purpose of:

- To Elect officers for the Nassau County Organization for the ensuing year, a Commander, three Vice Commanders (of equal rank), Adjutant, and Treasurer.
- 2. To Elect Delegates and Alternates to the Convention of the Department of New York to be held in Syracuse, New York on July 15, 2025, to July 19, 2025 (Tuesday through Saturday inclusive). Nassau County is entitled to Delegates at large and one additional Delegate and Alternate for each 250 paid-up memberships prior to thirty days before the date of said Department Convention as reported by the Department of New York. The remaining Delegates and Alternates to which the County is entitled according to its membership as provided in the Department Constitution and Bylaws,' shall be elected at the County Convention after nominations by the Divisions at their respective Caucuses held for that purpose at the County Convention.
- 3. All Post are to be represented by One (1) Delegate and One (1) Alternate for the first Fifteen (15) members plus One (1) Delegate and One (1) Alternate for each additional Twenty-five (25) members or a major fraction thereof. Membership figures will be based on paid up cards in the hands of the Department of New York or the County Membership Chair, whichever is greater, on June 14, 2025.

All Past County Commanders in good standing will be given a vote. All lists of Delegates and Alternates should be forwarded to the County Adjutant prior to June 14, 2025. This list should also indicate which way the Post intends to vote, whether Unit Rule or Uninstructed. To execute the Unit Rule, fifty percent or better of the Post Delegation must be present at Roll Call. All Posts should retain a copy of this information for future reference at the County Convention.

To transact with such other business as may come before the Delegates assembled and to consider such matters as the County may desire to bring before the Department Convention.
